

Inverclyde Amateur Swimming Club have a highly successful meet at Cumbernauld

The event was held over two days with the younger swimmers swimming on the Saturday. On the Saturday IASC had 3 swimmers taking part in a total of 10 events. The Star of the Day being Enrico Mazzoni who achieved a Silver Medal 11 year olds 100 metres Breast Stroke and a 5th Place in the 50 metres Freestyle and 6th in 100 metres Intermediate Medley along with achieving personal best times in 3 events. Laura Atkinson also managed to achieve a creditable 5th place in the Girls 10 year's olds 50 metres Freestyle and an overall 10th Place 100 meters Freestyle in a very well attended meet at the Tryst Sports Centre. Again Laura managed to achieve personal best times in 3 of her 4 events. 10 year old Aiden Grant also took part in the days events achieving 3 personal best times.

On the Sunday Better was to come from the 12 to 14 year old swimmers achieving personal best times in 26 of the 28 races that Inverclyde took part in. There was also a clutch of medals for IASC with Clare McGachy receiving a Bronze Medal in the 100 Intermediate Medley and finishing in the top 6 in all of her other races achieving personal bests. For the Boys 14 year old Andrew Hemphill had an excellent day achieving an overall 3rd in all events and along the way picking up a gold medal in 200 metres Freestyle, Silver in the 100 metres Breaststroke and a Bronze in the 100 metres Freestyle.

Amy Young Girls 12 years old achieved Personal Bests in the following events 100metres Backstroke, 200 metres Freestyle, and 100 metres Freestyle

Emily Buchan 12 years old achieved Personal Bests in the following events 100 metres Backstroke, 100 metres Intermediate Medley, 200 metres Freestyle, and 100 metres Breaststroke.

Mark Meahan 12 years old achieved Personal Bests in the following events 100 metres Intermediate Medley, 100 metres Freestyle gaining and overall 11th Place 100 metres Breaststroke and 100 metres Freestyle.

Jamie Purdie 12 years old achieved Personal Bests in the following events 100 metres Backstroke, 100 metres intermediate Medley and 200 metres Freestyle.

Nicholas Brown 13 years of age and in only his second competition gained a 13th Place overall in the 100 metres Freestyle.

Gerrard Hennan 13 year's old achieved personal best times in the 200 metres freestyle, 100 metres Breaststroke and 100 Meters Back Stroke.
